21 Days of Prayer Focuses & Scriptures

DAY 1 — Sunday, January 6th

LOCATION — The Bridge: Taste of Freedom at 6PM

Prayer Focus: Freedom From Addiction

Scripture: John 8:34 -36 “I speak eternal truth,” Jesus said. “When you sin you are not free. You’ve become a slave in bondage to your sin. And slaves have no permanent standing in a family, like a son does, for a son is a part of the family forever. So if the Son sets you free from sin, then become a true son and be unquestionably free!”

Also, Psalm 146; Luke 4:18-19; Romans 6:22

DAY 2 — Monday, January 7th

Prayer Focus: A Spirit of Repentance & Consecration

Scripture: Psalm 51:7,10 & 12 “Purify me from my sins, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and make me willing to obey you.”

Also, James 4:7-10; John 17:17

DAY 3 — Tuesday, January 8th

Prayer Focus: The Fear of the Lord (healthy reverence for God)

Scripture: Hebrews 12:28-29 “Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. For our God *is* a consuming fire.” *Also, Psalm 33:18-22; Psalm 145*

DAY 4 — Wednesday, January 9th

Prayer Focus: Identity in Christ

Scripture: Romans 8:15-17 “ For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father!” The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs — heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.”

Also, Galatians 2:20; Matthew 5:14; Romans 8:15-17

DAY 5 — Thursday, January 10th

**Prayer Focus: Inner Healing & Restoration of the Inner Life
(peace, hope and joy)**

Scripture: Romans 15:13 “Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.” *Also, Philippians 4:6-9; Psalm 103:1-5*

DAY 6 — Friday, January 11th

Prayer Focus: A Revelation of Jesus

Scripture: John 1:14 “So the Word became human and made His home among us. He was full of unending love and faithfulness. And we have seen His glory, the glory of the Father’s one and only Son.”
Also, Ephesians 3:16-19; Psalm 27:4

DAY 7 — Saturday, January 12th

**Prayer Focus: Increased Hunger for God & Decreased Appetite
for the Things of this World**

Scripture: Matthew 5:6 “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled!”
Also, John 6:35; Matthew 16:24:27, 2 Timothy 2:22

DAY 8 — Sunday, January 13th

**Prayer Focus: Culture of Humility & Honor Among Young
Believers**

Scripture: Colossians 3:12-14 “Therefore, as *the* elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also *must do*. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.” *Also, Ephesians 5:1-2; Romans 12:3*

DAY 20 — Friday, January 25th

Prayer Focus: Boldness to Live Out the Faith & Proclaim the Gospel

Scripture: Colossians 1:9-11 "...that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy!"

Also, 2 Thessalonians 3:1-5; Acts 4:29-31

DAY 21 — Saturday, January 26th

Prayer Focus: Praying for Students & Staff Who Have Lost Their Way or Not Yet Found Jesus

Scripture: Romans 5:8 "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

Also, Matthew 9:12-13; Matthew 18:10-14; Ezekiel 36:26

DAY 9 — Monday, January 14th

Prayer Focus: For a Spirit of Diligence, Faithfulness, & Commitment (endurance)

Scripture: Romans 5:1-5 "Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. And not only *that*, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces [b]perseverance; and perseverance, [c]character; and character, hope. Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us."

Also, Hebrews 12:1-3; 1 Timothy 6:12

DAY 10 — Tuesday, January 15th

Prayer Focus: Increased Hunger for the Word of God & for Truth

Scripture: Psalm 27:4 & 8 "One *thing* I have desired of the Lord, That will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in His temple. — *When You said*, "Seek My face," my heart said to You, "Your face, Lord, I will seek."

Also, Ephesians 1:17-19; Proverbs 9:10; John 4:23

DAY 11 — Wednesday, January 16th

LOCATION — New Life Community Church at 6PM

Prayer Focus: Restoration of Families

Scripture: Luke 4:18-19 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, for He has anointed Me to bring Good News to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim that captives will be released, that the blind will see, that the oppressed will be set free, and that the time of the Lord's favor has come."

Also, Psalm 70:19-21; Joel 2:25-26

DAY 12 — Thursday, January 17th

Prayer Focus: Mental Healing & Wholeness

Scripture: Philippians 4:8-9 “Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things *are* noble, whatever things *are* just, whatever things *are* pure, whatever things *are* lovely, whatever things *are* of good report, if *there is* any virtue and if *there is* anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.”

Also, Proverbs 3:5-6; Romans 12:2; 2 Corinthians 5:17

DAY 13 — Friday, January 18th

Prayer Focus: A Spirit of Prayer

Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 “Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.”

Also, Ephesians 6:18; Luke 2:36-38

DAY 14 — Saturday, January 19th

Prayer Focus: Wisdom & Favor for School Faculty & Staff

Scripture: James 3:17-18 “But the wisdom from above is always pure, filled with peace, considerate and teachable. It is filled with love and never displays prejudice or hypocrisy in any form and it always bears the beautiful harvest of righteousness! Good seeds of wisdom’s fruit will be planted with peaceful acts by those who cherish making peace.” *Also, Luke 2:52; Proverbs 3:3-5*

DAY 15 — Sunday, January 20th

Prayer Focus: Radical Pursuit of Purity, Holiness & Love

Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 3:12-13 “And may the Lord make you increase and abound in love to one another and to all, just as we *do* to you, so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints.” *Also, Matthew 5:8; 1 Timothy 1:5; 1 Peter 1:22-23; Philippians 1:9-11*

DAY 16 — Monday, January 21st

Prayer Focus: Divine Protection over Hearts & Minds

Scripture: 2 Samuel 22:2-4 “The Lord *is* my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, My stronghold and my refuge; My Savior, You save me from violence. I will call upon the Lord, *who is worthy* to be praised; So shall I be saved from my enemies!”

Also, Psalm 18:35; Psalm 84:11; Psalm 91

DAY 17 — Tuesday, January 22nd

Prayer Focus: Unity, Camaraderie & a Sense of Family Among Young Christians

Scripture: Romans 15:5-7 “Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus, that you may with one mind *and* one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God.”

Also, Philippians 2:1-7; Colossians 3:12-17; John 15:12-13

DAY 18 — Wednesday, January 23rd

Prayer Focus: Spiritual Fathers & Mothers (more involvement from the Church in mentoring & encouraging young people)

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 4:15-16 “For though you might have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet *you do* not *have* many fathers; for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel. Therefore I urge you, imitate me.”

DAY 19 — Thursday, January 24th

Prayer Focus: Eternal Perspective

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 4:16-18 “Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward *man* is being renewed day by day. For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding *and* eternal weight of glory, while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen *are* temporary, but the things which are not seen *are* eternal.”
