

“He will bring a reward” Pt 1

1 Chronicles 12:32

“And of the children of *Issachar*, *which were men that had understanding of the times*, to *know* what *Israel* ought to do; the heads of them were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their *commandment*”

- *Issachar* – The meaning of this name is “*he will bring a reward*”
- His children or generations had – *Understanding* - meaning – To separate mentally, to distinguish, be cunning, diligently, deal wisely, be prudent
- [They had a understanding of the *Times* – meaning: Occurrences
Fortunes means success, prosperity, estates, possessions, wealth
(Webster’s Dictionary)
Occurrence means an event, an incident, happenings, circumstance.

**The Sons, the Children of Issachar [*“He will bring a reward”*]
Had a understanding – They could distinguish – they were wise
To the Times – Success, prosperity, estates, possessions, wealth, events,
incidents, to circumstances.**

How?

Well the word of God tells us that they had this understanding so they would KNOW what *Israel* [*God Prevails*] ought to do.

- *Know* – meaning -To know or ascertain **by seeing**

The *Hebrew word* **know** in this verse is [*“Yada”* - which is a word that **Means**: *God gives the personal understanding and revelation, and is not a knowing that comes from reading a book for example*]

So we see that literally by virtue of the name *Issachar* - [*“he will bring a reward”*] - we see that those who walk in the character and calling of *Issachar* bring a sure reward to the Lord as well as a reward to the vineyard or ministry that they are working

Somebody shout – I want to be one who carries forth the rewards of the Lord – I want to be one that understands the times and will know what those of God need to do!

1 Chronicles 12:32

“And of the children of Issachar, which were men that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ["God prevails"] ought to do; the heads of them were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their commandment”

* Their mind is cunning, able to mentally distinguish between that which is wise and unwise.

* They diligently pursue the understanding needed to live well before the Lord.

Issachar men and women receive understanding from the Lord Himself, because they know God in an intimate manner.

Because they are wise and prudent, Issachars are able to perceive and seize opportune times – God Seasons with revelatory knowledge.

1 Chronicles 12:32

“And of the children of Issachar, which were men that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ["God prevails"] ought to do; the heads of them were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their commandment”

* Another key word found in the above scripture is commandment.

Commandment means: the mouth as the means of blowing, particularly speech; to puff, blow away

As the sons of Issachar walk in revelatory understanding, born out of an intimate knowing of the Lord, the very words of their mouth will possess great authority/power, providing them with the ability to lead others.
