Lesson: Revelation 10:1-11

“Just before the last Storm”

Revelation 10:1-4 [KJ]

“1 And *I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven*, **clothed** with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire:

2 *And he had in his hand a little book open*: and he **set his right foot** upon the sea, and **his left foot** on the earth,

3 And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, *seven thunders uttered their voices*”

4 And when *the seven thunders had uttered their voices*, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not”

Revelation 10: 1-4 [Message]

“I saw another powerful Angel coming down out of Heaven wrapped in a cloud. There was a rainbow over his head, his face was sun-radiant, his legs pillars of fire. He had a small book open in his hand. He placed his right foot on the sea and his left foot on land, then called out thunderously, a lion roar. When he called out, the Seven Thunders called back. When the Seven Thunders spoke, I started to write it all down, but a voice out of Heaven stopped me, saying, "Seal with silence the Seven Thunders; don't write a word"

Introduction

- * We are in another one of the *parenthetical* passages in Revelation.
- * If you will remember, we encountered one of these between the *six and the seventh seals*.
- * Parenthetical [A parenthesis] in the prophecy

Now - **at this point** we are *between the sixth* and the *seventh trumpets*.

- * So between them we find this *parenthetical* passage – [*Parenthesis*]

2.

There are several reasons why the Lord gives us these pauses in the action.

One reason is to give the reader a break

- * We have been studying terrible scenes of tragedy and death.
- * He gives us these pauses to allow us to regroup and gather our emotions.
- * These pauses allow the Lord to give us words of encouragement and comfort.

Another reason He does this is to show everyone Who is truly in control

- * As you read about the horrors of the *Tribulation Period* - you might conclude that sin and Satan are in control.
- * But, God steps in to remind us that He is still the Sovereign God of the universe!
- * God wants us to know that regardless of how dark the hour becomes and in spite of what the devil and his crowd might do, God is still on His throne and He is still in control of all things!

These pauses also serve to focus our attention on the blessed Lamb of God

- * In the midst of His wrath, we desperately need to be reminded of His great power.

You see, there is one fundamental problem with the world today; the world leave Jesus out of its calculations and plans

- * This world has cut Jesus, the Son, out of the picture and they have replaced Him with the United Nations and other faulty man made institutions.
- * The result has been total chaos.

When Jesus is restored as the focal point of mankind's attention, then all things will make sense and fall into place.

That is what God is up to here

- * By the way this will work in an individual's life as well!
- * Restore Jesus as the focal point of your attention – very center of your life and the point man of your daily purpose and you will see chaos come to order

Revelation 10

This passage introduces the middle of the tribulation period. It also serves to place Jesus back on center stage. Let's notice what is taking place upon the earth as we see *"Just before the last Storm"*

- * Like the shining through of the sun in the midst of an earth-shaking storm this chapter brings us relief and hope.
- * It is one of the chapters about the Apocalypse that turns our eyes upon Jesus.

Revelation 10: 1

"1 And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven..."

- * John sees a *"mighty angel"* descending from *Heaven*.
- * We are not given the identity of this angel.
- * Some people believe it could be Gabriel the archangel.
- * Others Michael

I am going to suggest that this angel is none other than the Lord Jesus Christ

- * As you may remember, Jesus showed up in the OT all the time.
- * These *pre-Bethlehem* appearances are called *"Theophanies or Christophanies"*

Jesus appeared to Abraham at his tent door

Jesus appeared the Samson's mother and father

Jesus appeared to Joshua outside Jericho

Jesus met with Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego in the furnace

Jesus helped Daniel in the Lion's den

Just to name a few.

4.

Revelation 10:1-4 [KJ]

“1 And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire...”

We Are Told Of His Dwelling Place

John 3:13

“And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven”

* This angel comes down from the very place Jesus Christ dwells

Hebrews 1: 1-3 [KJ]

“1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,

2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high”

* Jesus is at this time sitting at the right hand of the Father

Hebrews 10: 12 [KJ]

“But this man [Jesus], after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God...”

WE find in Revelation 10: 1 That John sees a Might Angel come down from Heaven

We Are Told Of His Dwelling Place

Revelation 10:1-4 [KJ]

“1 And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud...”

We Are Told Of His Description**He Is Clothed With A Cloud**

* The cloud is garment of deity

Psalm 104: 3

“Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters: who maketh the clouds his chariot: who walketh upon the wings of the wind”!

* In the Old Testament, during the wilderness wanderings, the Lord Himself led His people with a glory cloud through the desert [Ex. 16]

* The Cloud by Day – Fire by Night

* The Lord was with them to guide them and guard them then.

Now we find in the Book of Revelation the darkest days the earth will ever see

My friends the Lord Jesus is still with His people to protect them and lead them.

When Jesus ascended back to Heaven, a cloud received Him**Acts 1:9**

“And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight”

When He returns, He will do so on the clouds**1 Thessalonians 4:16-17**

“ 13 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep [dead], that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.

14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep [died] in Jesus will God bring with him.

6.

15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

18 Wherefore comfort one another with these words”

Revelation 1: 7

“ 3 Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;

5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

6 And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty”

He is clothed with a cloud and a Rainbow on His Head

Revelation 10:1-4 [KJ]

“1 And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire:

He Has A Rainbow Upon His Head

- * The **rainbow** is a symbol of the mercy and faithfulness of God.
- * It first appeared in **Genesis 9** after the flood to guarantee the Lord’s promise that He would never destroy the earth with water again.

It also appears in Revelation 4: 1-3 “1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.

2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne.

3 And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald”

- * The throne of God is surrounded with an emerald rainbow.
- * Here, it is a symbol of His mercy and faithfulness

He is clothed with a cloud and a Rainbow on His Head and His face Shines like the Sun

Revelation 10:1-4 [KJ]

“1 And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun...”

His Face Shines Like The Sun

- * This a description of His glory!
- * When Jesus walked the dusty roads of this world, He appeared to be an ordinary man.
- * So ordinary that He did not stand out as anyone special by His appearance alone

Isaiah 53: 1-5 [KJ]

“ 1 **Who hath believed our report?** And to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

2 For *he shall grow up before him as a tender plant*, and as a root out of a dry ground: *he hath no form nor comeliness*; and *when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.*

3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed”

He concealed His heavenly fame within His earthly frame

Philippians 2: 5-8

“ 5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

7 *But made himself of no reputation*, and *took upon him the form of a servant*, and was *made in the likeness of men...*”

His glory came out in Matthew 17:1-8 “1 And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light”

* The glory that was on the inside became visible on the outside and Matthew tells us that Jesus outshone the sun!

9.

When Saul of Tarsus [who is the Apostle Paul] met Him on the road to Damascus, Jesus was brighter than the noonday sun.

Acts 9 [Message]

“ 1-2 All this time Saul was breathing down the necks of the Master's disciples, out for the kill. He went to the Chief Priest and got arrest warrants to take to the meeting places in Damascus so that if he found anyone there belonging to the Way, whether men or women, he could arrest them and bring them to Jerusalem.

3-4 He set off. When he got to the outskirts of Damascus, *he was suddenly dazed by a blinding flash of light*. As he fell to the ground, he heard a voice: "Saul, Saul, why are you out to get me?"

5-6 He said, "Who are you, Master?" "I am Jesus, the One you're hunting down. I want you to get up and enter the city. In the city you'll be told what to do next”

- * By the way, men love darkness, but when the Light shines on their sins, they are brought to their knees before the glorious Lamb of God**
- * Jesus out shines the physical sun!**
- * Aren't you glad Jesus Shed His Light on Your Sins!**

**He is clothed with a cloud and a Rainbow on His Head and His face
Shines like the Sun His feet are like Pillars of Fire**

Revelation 10:1-4 [KJ]

“1 And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and *his feet as pillars of fire...*”

His Feet Are Like Pillars Of Fire

- * This is a picture of His judgment.**
- * When Jesus comes, He is not coming as the Savior.**
- * He is coming back as the Sovereign Lord of the universe.**

He is coming to execute judgment on all those who have rejected Him!

His feet are like pillars of fire

- * The word “*pillars*” also brings to mind images of *firmness, stability and strength*.
- * We are looking at a God Who is rock steady and able to carry through with His mission.
- * He is going to judge this world, the sinners in the world and Satan himself, and no being will be able to prevent Him from doing what He intends to do!

Revelation 10:1-4 [KJ]

“1 And *I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire...*”

- * A Mighty Angel [Jesus though-out the Old Testament is pictured as the Angel of the Lord – Mighty Angel
- * He is clothed with a cloud and a Rainbow on His Head and His face Shines like the Sun His feet are like Pillars of Fire

This give us a description of the *Character of Jesus Christ*

- * From Generation to Generation He has watched men persecute His Saints, squander His blessings and the wealth of this world, abuse His creation and deny His existence
- * But Jesus is coming Back!
- * Here in Chapter 10 of the Apocalypse we see that His return coming soon.

John next draws our attention to the Lords Claims.

Revelation 10: 2- 3[KJ]

“2 And he had in his hand a little book open: and *he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth,*

3 And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices”

We are told of His Dominion

- * This by the way is not the Lord final coming
- * What we have here is the formal assertion by Jesus of His right to a reign

It has been acknowledged already in Heaven

Revelation 5: 5

“5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof”

Now it was about to be acknowledged on Earth

Revelation 10: 2- 3[KJ]

“2 And he had in his hand a little book open: and he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth,

3 And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices”

- * Here is a wonderful picture of our Lord.
- * He is standing with one foot on the land, one foot on the sea and He has a little book in His hand.

This is a picture of His dominion over the entire world

- * In ancient time, when a person was going to take dominion over a place or a person, he put his foot on it.

When God gave Canaan to Israel, He said: “Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses” [Joshua 1:3]

When one king would conquer another king, he would place his foot on the defeated king’s neck as a symbol of total domination.

The Lord asserts this right to rule

- * He has the Book
- * He is ruling in compliance with the mind and will of God
- * All unfulfilled prophecies and promises will now come to pass

Moses said to Israel, “Every place whereon the soles of your feet shall tread shall be yours” [Deuteronomy 11:24]

So Jesus by Heavenly rights and God assurance plants His feet upon the sea and upon the earth – He claims them all from pole to pole, from shinning sea to shinning sea - He is Jesus Christ the Savior of the World

Revelation 10: 2- 3[KJ]

“2 And he had in his hand a little book open: and he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth,

3 And *cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth*: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices”

- * We are also told that He “*cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth*”
- * It is said that the roaring of a lion can strike fear into the bravest heart.

An adult male lion’s roar can be heard as far as five miles away

- * Lion’s usually roar just after sunset.
- * They do so to proclaim a place as their territory.
- * That is what we are seeing in these verses. The Lord is staking His claim and He is saying, *‘I am the Lion of the Tribe of Judah’*

We see the victorious Jesus laying claim to the planet earth. He holds in His hand the book, which is the title deed to the planet. He stands with one foot on the dry land and another on the sea. Jesus has come to take control of this world.

He has come to accomplish the will of God!

Revelation 10: 3-4 [KJ]

“3 And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.

Seven Thunders Uttered Their Voices

*** John hears seven thunders speaking.**

John gives us an example of one who is paying attention to the voice of the Lord – always in a position with the Lord to hear, to see, to move.

*** Apparently the seven thunders that broke forth spoke a language John could understand and he got ready to write down what they were saying.**

But, the Lord stopped him and told John to seal up those things that he heard the thunders say.

So, what did they say?

*** I do not know!**

*** Neither does any one else!**

*** Why write about it if we are not told what they say?**

*** John heard them and was ready to write them down but was not allowed.**

God has some things that He wants to keep concealed for the time being.

*** The reason God puts this here is very simple I think.**

*** He wants to teach us a very valuable lesson.**

*** He wants us to know that there are just some things in life that are going to remain a mystery!**

Deuteronomy 29:29

“The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law”

There are thousands of questions in life for which you and do not have answers.

- * Why do good people suffer?
- * Why do babies get sick and die?
- * Why is there so much evil in our world?
- * Why is living holy so hard?
- * Just simply the big question is WHY?

We will never have the answers to these and ten thousand other questions this side of Heaven.

- * The best thing we can do is to leave the mysteries with the Lord and trust Him to do right.
- * Right now, we are looking at life from earth - we are looking through a very limited window.
- * One day, we will be allowed to look from Heavens vantage point and the window will not be restricted; it will be very large and clear.

It will make sense then!

- * Paul says, [1 Corinthians 13:12](#) “For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known”

Seven Thunders Uttered Their Voices

[Rev.10:4](#) “4 And when *the seven thunders had uttered their voices*, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not”

[Revelation 10: 5-7](#) [KJ]

“5 And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth *lifted up his hand to heaven*, 6 And *sware by him that liveth for ever and ever*, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer: 7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets”

Seven Thunders Uttered Their Voices There Were Voices Of Manifestation

- * While the voices of the thunders remain a mystery, the next voice John hears brings a message that is crystal clear.
- * The Person John saw lifts His holy hands and makes a tremendous promise.
- * He tells John that the days of waiting are finished.
- * God is preparing to consummate His work and complete His Word.

God is preparing to bring His work of judgment and redemption to an end.

- * In case you have forgotten, God does not operate like we do.
- * His timetable is vastly different from ours.
- * We think we are in a period of delay.
- * We think things are moving so slowly.
- * We think God will never fulfill all the promises He has made.
- * Well, we are wrong! God wears a different kind of timepiece than we do.

2 Peter 3:8 [KJ]

“8 But, beloved, *be not ignorant of this one thing*, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

9 *The Lord is not slack concerning his promise*, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

10 *But the day of the Lord will come* as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up”

- * You see, it appears that sin and Satan are willing the battle
- * The truth is far different
- * Satan and Sin are on Gods Time Table
- * God will, I said He will deal with them in His Time
- * But remember for certain God is going to fulfill His promise!

At a Chicago Cubs baseball game

A fellow in the right field stand was kid of late getting to his seat so he hollered down to the Cardinal fielder and asked “*how's our team doing?*”

The Cubs fielder replied: “*Well, we're not doing so good.*”

The fellow in the stands said: “*Well what's the score, son?*”

The Cubs fielder said?: “*They're beating us 23 to nothing.*”

The fan in the stands said: “*Boy, that is bad, that's just real bad.*”

The Cubs out-fielder said: “*Aw, yes sir, but it's not too bad - we have not got in to bat yet*”

Listen the *St. Louis Cardinals*, I mean the *devil* is up to bat right now but *one of these days* the Cubs, no I mean God's is going to come up to the plate and there'll be no more delay.

2 Peter 3:8 [KJ]

“8 But, beloved, *be not ignorant of this one thing*, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

* According to God's calendar, Jesus has only been gone two days.

* 2,000 years

* We are in the Third Day – Resurrection Day!

* Soon, God is going to turn the page, tell Gabriel to blow his trumpet and Jesus will return for His church.

* Then, God will judge the earth, sin and the devil and usher in eternity.

It won't be long now! Hallelujah!

Batter UP!

Revelation 10: 8-11 [KJ]

“8 And *the voice which I heard from heaven* spake unto me again, and said, Go and take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth.

9 And *I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book.* *And he said unto me, Take it, and eat it up;* and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.

10 *And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.*

11 And he said unto me, *Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings*”

John is told to take the little book out of the hand of the Angel

* He is told to eat it, but he is warned that the book will be sweet in his mouth and bitter in his stomach.

* John does as he is told and finds that the words of the Angel are true.

The book was sweet as honey to his taste; but it was bitter in his belly

* Then John is told that he is to take the message he has taken is and share it with others who need to hear.

This is a strange little section of Scripture. It does, however, teach a couple of lessons about the Word of God that we need to hear today.

The Word Of God Is To Be Swallowed

The Bible is spiritual food. Jesus said: Matthew 4:4 “But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God”

Jeremiah said: Jeremiah 15:16 “Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts”

Job said: Job 23:12 “I have esteemed the words of his mouth more than my necessary food”

Peter said: 1 Peter 1:22 “As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby”

There is something special about this Book!

It is food for the hungry soul. It is a balm for the hurting soul. It is meat for the growing soul.

Eating is an easily recognized symbol for receiving knowledge in scripture

- * We digest a piece of information
- * John is told to eat the of Book

When John swallowed the Book, he found that it was both a blessing and burden.

- * It was sweet and it was bitter at the same time.

The sweetness of this Book can be found in its passages about the grace, love and mercy of our God.

- * When we read of Jesus dying for our sins and rising from the dead it is so very sweet.
- * When we read of Heaven; it is so sweet.
- * When we read that He will meet our needs; never leave us; and come to take us home some day that is also so sweet!
- * When the sinner reads that Jesus will save him if he will only come to Jesus by faith that is sweeter than words can describe.

The Bible is a book filled with sweetness!

The Bible is also a Book filled with bitterness

- * This Book tells us about a Hell that awaits all the lost.
- * It is this Book that the Spirit of God uses to convict the hearts of saints and sinners alike of sin.
- * This Book tells of judgment, wrath and damnation.
- * It is a bitter book too.

When we take the whole Book, the bitter and the sweet, the blessings and the burdens, we are able to say that it fits together so well.

- * It reveals our problems, but it always points us to the right solution.
- * Praise the Lord for the Word of God!

Revelation 10: 11 [KJ]

11 And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings"

The Word Of God Is To Be Shared

- * John was told to share the message of the Book with others.
- * The same burden has been placed on our shoulders today.
- * We are to take this Book with both its blessings and its burdens and we are to share its message with a lost and dying world

Matthew 28:18-20 [KJ]

" 18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen"

Mark 16:15 [KJ]

" 15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover"

He gave us His Word to share with the world. Let us go forth with the Word of God in our hearts and one our lips and tell a lost world that "*Jesus Saved; Jesus Saves*"!

Conclusion
